






MARIA SKŁODOWSKA-CURIE

Maria Skłodowska-Curie is a world-famous Polish inventor and two-time Nobel laureate. She developed radioactivity theories, techniques for separating radioactive isotopes, discovered the two elements, radium and polonium, thus going down in history as one of the world's greatest inventors.







Lublin is the largest and most dynamically developing urban centre in eastern Poland. As the capital of the Lubelskie Voivodeship, it plays the role of the region's administrative, economic and cultural centre.




